

Systems / multifunctional approach at project and / or programme level?

At project level:

- Improve stakeholder involvement in R&I projects. DG AGRI multi-actor approach
- Multi-disciplinarity / transdisciplinarity, social science and humanities
- Site-specific and multi-scales (farm / landscape / region / EU...) – Horizon Europe agricultural R&I: more place-based work
- Risk to put too much at project level work on everything and nothing at the same time





At programme level:

- Constant dialogue with other services / ministries, stakeholders, Member States, etc. to feed long-term vision – focus on key strategies and issues (too many strategies kill strategies)
- Breaking silos and / or making silos work together
- Long-term approach to R&I financing, complementarity EU /
 MS level recurrent funding / competitive funding
- Overall R&I ecosystem: strong basic research, applied research and innovation, AKIS
- Steer synergies at EU level in key areas of work (EJP One Health; EJP soil)
- From project to programme: provide a **backbone** (R&I infrastructure, continuity of work, LT time series)






At global level:

- Global cooperation on key issues: climate change (GRA);
 animal health (STAR-IDAZ), Wheat Initiative, etc.
- Coordination of efforts role of international research consortia (IRCs) – e.g. STAR-IDAZ
- CGIAR: commodity-based but more systems approach
- G-20 MACS: agro-ecosystems living labs
