

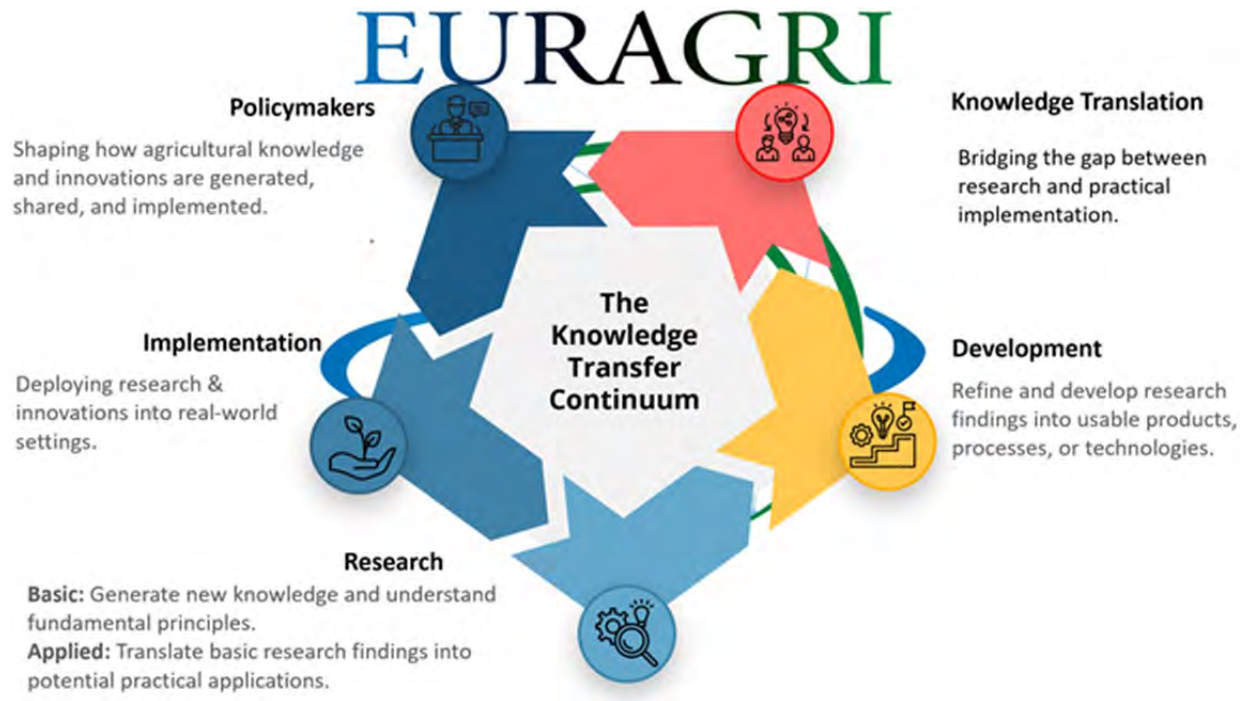

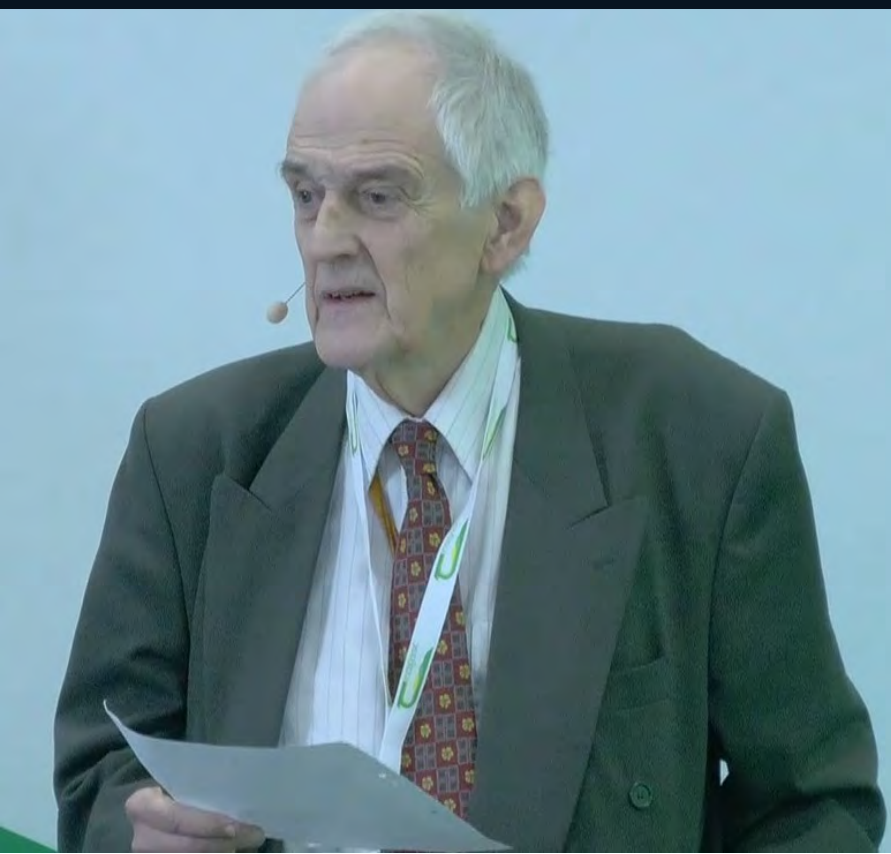
Euragri – who are we?

In the second quarter of 2025, EURAGRI in conjunction with one of our members and our network have hosted two important virtual events following up on the successful Portuguese meeting hosted by our member, MED, in March (ref).

The April 25 workshop “**The European Commission’s Strategic Dialogue and Vision for Agriculture and Food, Stakeholders Perspectives on Achieving the Vision**” hosted by Euragri in collaboration with our member organisation, the Austrian Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry, Regions and Water Management, explored the recommendations of the Strategic Dialogue and the Commission’s 2025 vision for sector and how these can be translated into actions (more details below).

The May 7 virtual seminar “**The Soybean Through World History, Protein Challenges for European Sustainable Agri-Food Systems**” developed together with our broader network reflected on the critical role of soybeans to global food security but also their contribution to agri-food system fragility. Dr Lisa Deutsch, co-author of The Soybean through World History, explored their complex global legacy and lessons for the future. Dr Ewen Mullins highlighted Europe’s reliance on soybean imports and introduced the Horizon Europe Valpro Path project’s work on sustainable plant protein solutions (more details below).

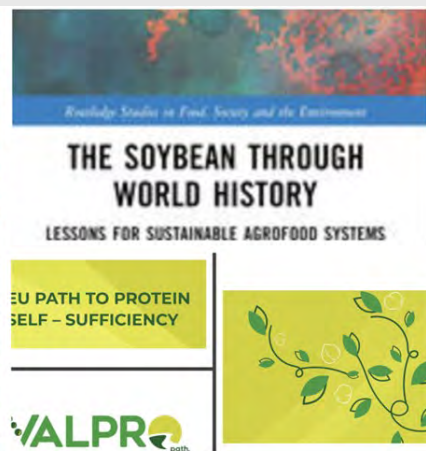
